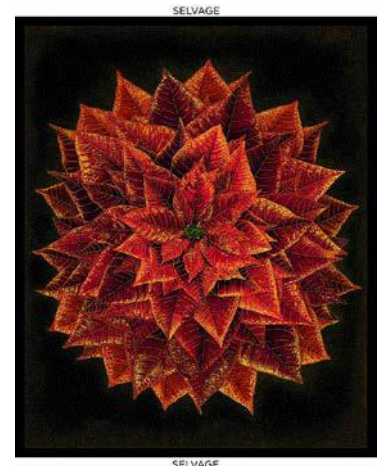

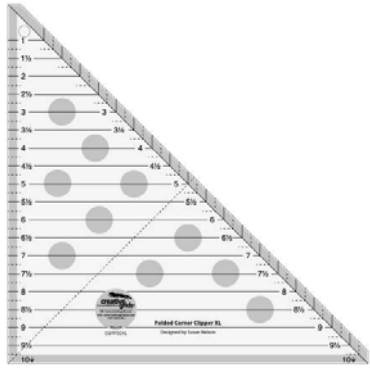

2022 Illusions Block of the Month

I am offering this lovely batik Block of Month quilt for 2022. The quilt finishes at 88" x 112" and has a variety of skill-building techniques as you construct the quilt. Traditional piecing, paper piecing, and applique are used throughout the quilt. Never fear, though, if you are not a fan of applique or paper piecing, I will be offering support workshops for these blocks OR some alternative piecing ideas-after all, it is YOUR quilt!



This is a 12-month program and each month you will receive a kit with the fabrics and instructions for that month's block. Your participation price will include the pattern, all fabrics for the top, border, and binding (19+ yards). Participation cost is \$25.00 per month.

Support workshops will be offered for the paper pieced and appliqued blocks.

1. Block kits are \$25.00 for each month and will contain fabrics for the block.
2. You may come in at any point during the month to purchase/pickup your block kit. Block kits for the next month are available on the fourth Saturday of the preceding month. (Ex: March blocks will be available on February 27). ****Note: if fabric shipments continue to fluctuate, I will notify you via e-mail when the kits are ready.**
3. **You can prepay the entire year for \$275. (Pre-pay gives you one month free!)**
4. If you pay monthly and miss picking/paying for a block without notifying us, your participation is considered cancelled.
5. We reserve the right to substitute similar fabric within color way based on fabric availability.

Machine Quilting-Free Motion Quilting I: Join me for this class and practice this exciting technique. You will learn machine set-up, the best threads, battings, etc. to use to make this technique successful. Enjoy the freedom this type of quilting gives you.

Date: Wednesday, August 4, 10 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Fee: \$45.00 includes fabric and batting for samples, book, thread, needles

You Bring:

- Sewing machine in good working order with feed dogs that drop
- Basic sewing supplies
- Free motion foot for machine



Introduction to Quilting: This six week class will take you through the piecing and quilting process as you make a baby/wallhanging size quilt. A detailed supply list will be available at registration. Quilt is on display at store.

Dates: Thursday, August 5, 12, 19, 26, September 2, 9; 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Fee: \$80.00- Detailed supply list when registering

Braided Twist Table Runner: Such a fun way to make a different looking table runner!

The curves are easy to piece and there is no binding, quilting, or handwork to finish!

Fee: \$40.00 (includes book and ruler)

You Bring:

- Sewing machine in good working order with feed dogs that drop
- Basic sewing supplies
- Items on detailed supply list



All About Batting: Join me for this lecture/demo class that explains all about battings. You will received a "practice kit" of the different batting samples for reference and practice.

Date: Saturday, August 14, 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Fee: \$25.00 includes batting samples + thread

Introduction to Free Motion Ruler Work: You will have the chance to learn the basics of free-motion ruler work as we “play” with rulers. You **MUST** be comfortable with free-motion quilting for this class. We will be working with Angela Walter’s rulers and the Westalee Rulers. If you have rulers, please bring them with you.

Date: Wednesday, August 18, 10:00-12:00

Fee: \$40.00 includes fabrics and batting samples, and thread. Rulers will be available for your use in class.

You bring:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Basic sewing supplies
- 1 empty bobbin
- Ruler foot for your machine (NOTE: This is **NOT** your free-motion foot; it is a foot with built up sides to allow it to ride along the ruler edge. If you do not have this, check with us. We keep a high shank and low shank foot in stock but these will NOT fit all machines.)

Machine Quilting-Quilting with the Walking/Evenfeed Foot: Learn different patterns that you create with the walking/evenfeed foot. You can quilt beautiful designs with your feed dogs up and by using your walking foot!

Date: Saturday, August 21, 10:00-12:30 a.m.

Fee: \$40.00 includes fabric and batting for samples, thread, needles

You Bring:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Basic sewing supplies
- 1 empty bobbin
- Even feed/free motion foot

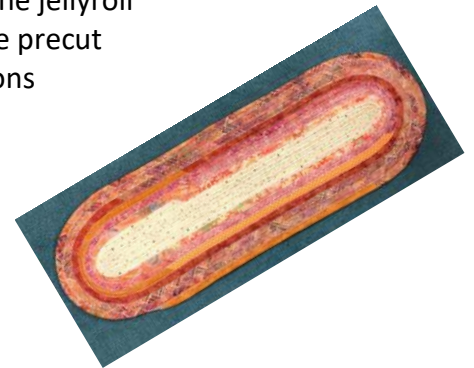
Oval Jellyroll Table Runner: Learn how to make an oval table runner using the jellyroll rug technique. This is the jellyroll rug-just a small scale! Class fee includes the precut batting and pattern for the Jellyroll rug. Supply list and pre-sewing instructions available when registering.

Date: Wednesday, September 8, 10:00-3:00

Fee: \$35.00 (include pattern and 25 yd. roll of precut 2-1/2” cotton batting)

You bring:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Basic sewing supplies
- Items on supply list



****New Class: Quilting Techniques-Flying Geese:** The Flying Geese unit is widely used in quilt blocks and many of us struggle to make them without cutting off the points! Join me as we work with several techniques to make these units and assemble into a finished block.

Fee: \$15.00 (includes all fabrics for samples)

You bring:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Basic sewing supplies
- Neutral thread for piecing



****New Class! Saturday, September 4 : Geese in the Cabin:** Learn to make this block using the Creative Grid 10" Log Cabin Trim Tool. The block combines log cabin piecing with stitch and flip accents to create the Flying Geese. The ruler makes sure that each block is the same size! Six different layouts. We will complete 1-2 blocks in class. Date: Saturday, September 4, 9:30 a.m. to 12: 30 p.m. Fee: \$40.00 (includes the ruler + pattern)

Questions about Sewing Classes

What are basic sewing supplies? Straight pins, snips, scissors, etc.

Do I need to make a deposit to hold my place in class? Yes, a deposit is needed to reserve your place in class.

What happens if I can't come to the class? If you cancel from the class 72 hours (3 days) or more BEFORE the class, your deposit will be refunded. If you fail to show for class, no refund will be given. A due bill can issued for the class; this must be used within six months of the scheduled class.

What happens if the store cancels the class? If the instructor/store cancels the class, your deposit will be refunded.

Do I need to bring my machine to class? Yes, you can bring your own machine as long it's in good working order and you are familiar with operating the machine. If your machine was purchased from The Sewing Center, we will be familiar with it and may be able to provide assistance. If the machine was purchases elsewhere, we may/may not be able to provide operating assistance or accessories.

What if I don't have a machine to bring to class? Please let us know when registering if you will need a machine and we'll be happy to provide one for you!

What do I do about lunch for all day classes? You may want to bring a sandwich; we have drinks available. Also, McDonald's, Zaxby's, Chik-Filet and a Chinese restaurant are close by if you wish to "go out" for lunch.

Can I bring someone else with me such as my mom or my son/daughter? No children or other non-paying persons are allowed to accompany class participant.
